E	Recycling
E	Explain recycling: Steps involved - sort, collect, clean, use to make new product, buy new product.
E	Discuss advantages: saves natural resources, protects environment, reduces waste, saves landfill space, etc.
E	Setting up the recycling centre
E	Discuss with other teachers the advantages and disadvantages of different collection schemes. Decide which will be the best for your school.
L	Find out the size of the different containers for plastics, paper, cans and glass.
L	Find the best place on the school property to put the containers and write down the reasons.
L	Find out and write down possible health, safety, fire and environmental risks. In groups discuss how to prevent them.
L	Prepare a "business or action plan" on how to set up a recycling scheme (Including who will be responsible to manage the scheme)
L	Use the following to advertise the recycling scheme : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● leaflets and posters ● collage ● slogan competition ● write and perform a play using musical instruments and costumes made from waste
E	Appoint a responsible person(s) to manage the recycling scheme
E	Implement and manage the recycling scheme according to the "business or action plan"
